



Who should attend:

Our course is ideal for anyone looking to bring their PAT testing in-house or for individuals looking to provide a PAT testing service to other companies.

We train people from many different industries & organisations, including caretakers, maintenance staff, office/clerical workers, landlords, charity shop workers... basically anyone in a workplace with electrical appliances.

What is covered:

The course objective is to understand how to conduct portable appliance testing with competence and safety in mind in accordance with the latest IET Code of Practice.

This includes understanding responsibilities and best practices, basic electrical principles, conducting and recording formal visual inspections, correctly identifying appliances (Class I, II, or III), setting appropriate testing frequencies, understanding and correctly interpreting test readings and much more.

In addition to the theory of PAT testing, participants will also learn how to use PAT instruments and conduct tests on a range of different appliances as well as understanding record keeping and labelling. The course concludes with a Q&A session giving attendees the opportunity to ask individual questions or request assistance with use of their PAT instruments.

Practical information:

Lunch is provided at all open courses as well as drinks and refreshments. Free parking at the venues is available but availability cannot be guaranteed.

We provide a copy of the IET Code of Practice for use during the course (you can also order a copy when booking your training course with us).

We bring a selection of PAT test instruments that you can use during the course, however if you already have a PAT tester then you are welcome to bring it along.

For on-site courses, we require you to provide a quiet, well-lit and adequately-sized space with chairs and table space. We will take care of the rest.

Certification:

The course features 3 open book assessments to help monitor the progress of candidates and ensure competency. Successful candidates will receive a Certificate of Competency in PAT Testing.
